Dear Mr. Kreunen:

I write to object to the proposed closing of Bain Station Road in Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin, between Highways 31 and H (88th Avenue). I believe it an unwise decision to limit access between the two highways to more heavily traveled arterials located some distance to either the north (Highway 50) or the south (95th Street). I believe that the closure of this road would have a negative impact on public safety, travel times, driver frustration and availability of an alternative route (should one or both of the proposed alternatives be blocked due to accident or congestion).

Those who travel Bain Station do so for various reasons. Limiting the choice of route for travelers preferring a direct and less congested route, limiting access for Fire and Rescue during wildfire events, and limiting efficient police response times between both sides of the Village, all seem irresponsible and ill-advised.

As a resident who would be directly affected by the closure, I respectfully request that you consider my objection with the utmost care and attention.
